CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS—ZONE 4 & NAMIBIAN JUNIOR OPEN

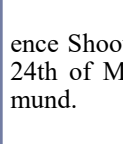

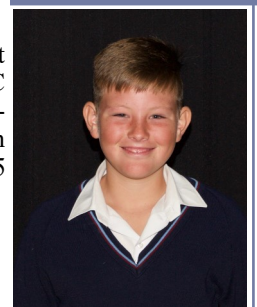
