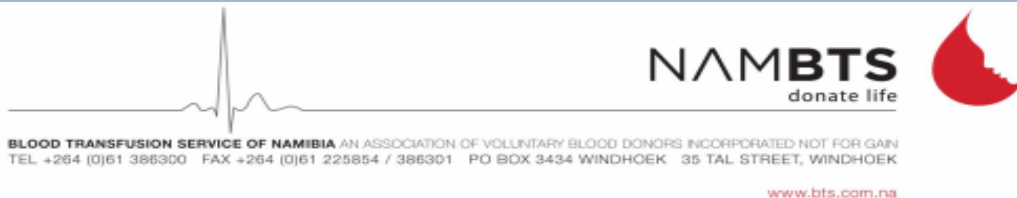


N\$50.00 fine must be paid to the financial secretary to release the cell phone at the end of the school day.
